Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011, Catholic parishes in the United States will begin praying the texts of the mass using a new English translation of the Roman Missal.

Biblical mercy is not like a game some of us played as children called Mercy! It is rather the relationship of mercy we see in the parable of the Prodigal Son. In this story, the wayward son, suffering in his misery, begins to see the sinfulness of his actions. He humbly repents and returns home to his father. The father sees the change of heart, his sorrow for his sins, and his noble desire to get his life back on track. The father sees this good in his son and eagerly welcomes him back. While the Kyrie is primarily an expression of repentance, it also can be seen as a petition, a prayer representing the cry of God's people for assistance in their lives. In the gospels, many people approach Jesus asking for his mercy in the sense of pleading for healing and help in their lives. We see this when the two blind men come to Jesus, saying, "Have mercy on us, Son of David" (Mt. 9:27; see also 20:30-31). One of the greatest examples in the Bible of how to ask for God's mercy is found in Psalm 51. King David humbly pours his heart out to God, asking for his mercy after having committed a serious sin. After examining our conscience and reciting the Confiteor, "I Confess," we too must humbly ask for the Lord's mercy.

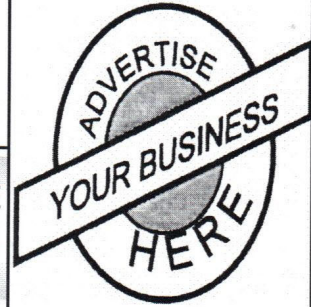

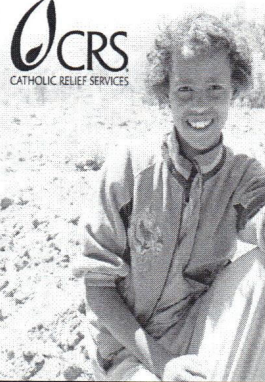

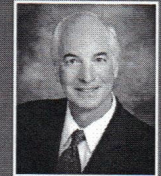
