Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

First, I would like to wish all mothers of our parish a Happy Mother Day. May God fill all mothers with love, grace and blessings. Second, I would like to inform you that as of July 1, 2011, I will be transferring to another parish, Our Lady of la Vang in Santa Ana. A few weeks ago, Bishop Brown informed me that he would like for me to take another parish assignment. I humbly accepted his decision. As a parish priest, I am under the direction of the local Ordinary. When the Bishop asks a priest to change his assignment, then he must be ready to accept his consideration. After two years here at St. Mary's, I have been very blessed to work with many of you and have come to know many of you, as well. Now I have to say goodbye, and I hope that the next priest, who will come in July, will continue to serve you. I would like to invite all of you to my farewell reception which will be held on Sunday, June 5th, after each Mass in the Family Room. My last day here at St. Mary's will be on Sunday June 12, 2011 after the 7:30 am Mass. I will be visiting Vietnam for two weeks in June before I enter my new parish assignment in Santa Ana. Third, I also want to congratulate the 15 First Holy Communion Students of our parish who just made their first communion yesterday. May the Lord continue to dwell in their hearts and their lives.

The theme for this Third Sunday of Easter is that **Jesus continues to live in our lives.**

Act: 2: 14, 22- 33 – The Peter who rises up to speak seems to be a completely different person from the Peter we had come to know in the gospels. This Peter is bold and courageous. He takes on the role of new leader of the community of followers of Jesus, and his words open the witness that will go out throughout the world. He has a message of hope linking together the present reality with the message of salvation of the prophets. In his words there is an essential confession of the Christian faith that will be forever proclaimed.

1 Peter 1: 17- 21 – The God who asked for holiness in the Hebrew Scriptures has been revealed in Jesus Christ as Father and one day will be revealed as Judge. This demands a style of life coherent with our faith. This lifestyle asks for sobriety and respect. The passion and glory of Christ is the Good News announced of which the disciple of Peter says is an incorruptible and permanent word of the living God

Luke 24: 13- 35 – The journey the disciples of Jesus had embarked on ended in disappointment and sadness. But Jesus makes a transition here and helps his friends to rectify their way by giving them a basis in Scripture and in their own experience of that Scripture by sharing the bread. The intention of Luke in this passage is to make clear the transition between the story of Jesus and the story of his witnesses. In reading the Gospel, we need to ask some questions: **What fears do I find harder to face? When have I felt disappointment and the feeling of failure? Who are the people around me that are defending life against the forces of death?** In short then, Jesus is always there to help us when our lives are in trouble.
