Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

For the next several months, we will be preparing for the New English Translation of the Roman Missal, which begins Nov. 27, 2011. I hope you will take the time to read the Pastor's Corner each week to prepare yourself for the changes.

The Roman Missal contains what the Church refers to as the "proper" antiphons for entrance and Communion time (in the United States, with the approval of our bishops, we commonly substitute hymns and songs for these "proper" antiphons). The Missal also contains prayers such as the Sign of the Cross and the greetings used at Mass. The opening prayer, the prayer over the bread and wine at the preparation of the gifts, and the prayer after Communion are all found in the Missal, as are the different Eucharistic prayers that are used at Mass and the blessings at the end of the liturgy. The Missal also contains all of the parts of the Mass that the people say or sing, such as the "I confess," the Gloria, the Creed, the Lord's Prayer, the Lamb of God, and our other responses. Some of these prayers are changed with the new translation; others remain the same.

Mission Co-Op

Next weekend, **July 30-31**, there will be a **Second Collection** taken for the Mission Co-Op Appeal. Fr. Henry Simaro, a native diocesan priest from Africa, will be speaking to us at all the Masses. Fr. Simaro runs a small church and orphanage schools for children orphaned because of HIV/Aids and other most vulnerable children in the slums and streets of Athi River, a dry dusty little town about an hour east of the capital of Nairobi. He has over 400 children (boys and girls) aged between 2-16 years old. Fr. Simaro has 2 elementary and 1 middle school for them, in an area where there is no running water, no medical clinics, and no agriculture due to drought. He is constantly struggling to fundraise for their education, medicine, nutrition, water and other pastoral care needs.

Fr. Simaro's main reason for coming to St. Mary's by the Sea is to make a special appeal to raise funds to construct a shelter/dormitory, dining hall and a chapel for the adequate care of these children. He wants to enable all the children to be able go to school, get medical care, nutrition and nourish their spiritual lives.

Please be as generous as possible and support Fr. Simaro's mission church and ministry.
