- Education: Fr. Chu studied English and electronic technology at Santa Ana College before resuming his studies for the priesthood. He had attended a high school seminary in Vietnam, but was unable to continue his education for the ministry after the fall of Saigon in 1975. He graduated from St. Joseph College, Mountain View, CA and St. John's Seminary, Camarillo CA.
