Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011, Catholic parishes in the United States will begin praying the texts of the mass using a new English translation of the Roman Missal.

Breaking Down Sections of the Mass with Changes

Examining the Introductory Rites

(continued from last week)

An Act of Penance:

*"I confess to almighty God
and to you, my brothers and sisters,
that I have **greatly** sinned,
in my thoughts and in my words,
in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,
**through my fault, through my fault,
through my most grievous fault;**
**therefore, I ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin
all the Angels and Saints,
and you, my brothers and sisters,
to pray for me to the Lord our God."***

(New Translation)

This next prayer in the Introductory Rite is known as the Confiteor, Latin for "I confess" (the first words of this prayer). In it we express sorrow over our sins – this is something the Bible calls us to do. This prayer challenges us to consider the four main ways we sin: "...in [our] thoughts, in [our] words, in what [we] have done, and in what [we] have failed to do." In the Bible we can read in Matthew 5:22; 5:27-28; 6:25-34; 7:1-3; how we can sin through our thoughts. In sins with our words we can read: 2Corinthians 12:20; Romans 1:30; Matthew 5:22; Colossians 3:9; 1Corinthians 5:6; and Ephesians 4:29. For what we have done: Galatians 5:19-21; Romans 13:12-13 and 2Timothy 3:2-6. Sin is not simply an evil action. James 4:17 teaches that we can also sin by failing to do the good we should do. These are known as "sins of omission." In Colossians 3:12-15 in this passage, we see the virtues of Christ who we should try and imitate. Confessing ones sins were sometimes done in a formal public ceremony of repentance (Neh 9:2). Other times, it was the spontaneous response of an individual (Ps 32:5; 38:18). Confessing one's sins was encouraged in the wisdom books of the Bible (Prv 28:13; Sir 4:26), and Old Testament law even required people to confess certain sins (Lv 5:5; Nm 5:7).

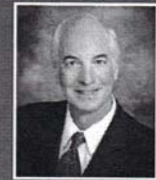
