Reflections of the Week

Getting to Know the Trinity

As difficult as it is to understand the Holy Trinity, it is amazing that Jesus even bothered to tell us about the Father, the Spirit, and Himself. As if his own life, his teachings about God's love, his miracles, his death and resurrection were not enough, he told us something about God that we never would have imagined: That there are three Persons in one God. It is also something we cannot completely comprehend. So instead of trying to explain it, let's look at what it means for us believers.

One thing it shows is that God wants to be known by us. Since theologians and spiritual writers have been helping us do that for almost two thousand years, it may not seem like a big deal. But in ancient times, people expected their gods to be mysterious and hidden. Many cultures thought that you could control a spirit or god if you knew its name. So knowing anything about the inner life of a god would be huge. But our God is the only God, whom no one can control. God sees us not as a threat but as beloved children. Just as a couple falling in love wants to know everything about each other, so God wants to be known by those whom God loves. That leads to our second point.

The Trinity also shows us that "God is love" (1 John 4:16) because the three Persons are united in one God. The Persons of the Trinity already love each other perfectly, so God shares that love with us. God calls us to be united in love with God and with each other. Remember that God knows us perfectly and still loves us. How many of us would want another person to know everything about us? Yet knowing our weaknesses and our sins does not hurt God's love for us. On the contrary, our weaknesses allow God to help us by answering our prayers or inspiring someone to come to our assistance. God permits us to sin, knowing that we can experience divine love in forgiveness. We may not be able to grasp the full meaning of the Holy Trinity, but knowing that God shares this with faithful people helps us to love God even more.

Church Manners

Parking in Front of the Church

There is to be **NO PARKING** in front of the Church. This is meant to be a **drop-off area** for people who are disabled or cannot walk far. Please do not use it as your person space and hinder those who need it.

Eucharistic Adoration & Exposition

St. Mary's by the Sea **opens the Church for Eucharistic Adoration every Monday through Friday from 1:00 to 4:30 pm.** On **Thursdays**, the **Divine Mercy Chaplet** will be recited at **3:00pm** and we will have **Eucharistic Exposition** (where the Blessed Sacrament is displayed outside the tabernacle in the monstrance for adoration by the faithful) from **3:00 to 7:30 pm**, closing with **Benediction** (praying the rosary and receiving a blessing with the Host) at **7:30 pm.**

2019 PSA Update - "We Are One"

Thank you to the **78 families** who have already pledged to support the mission of the Church in our Diocese through their commitment to the 2019 PSA. As of today, we have received **pledges of \$65,306 with \$55,771 of this already paid.** Since we have now met our diocesan goal, all additional gifts we receive from this point on will be returned straight back to us and used to construct two new ADA compliant restrooms.

In addition, each parish in the Diocese has been given an opportunity to receive an **incentive award of \$3,000** (in addition to any rebate we may earn over our diocesan goal) by simply increasing the number of PSA donors for 2019. In order for St. Mary's by the Sea to qualify, we need a **minimum of 8 additional donations**, so please, if you have not yet made your pledge, do so today. We are still hoping to meet our personal goal of \$85,000.
