### Reflections of the Week

#### *The Paradox of Faith*

"Fear no one," Jesus says. He is talking about fearing those who persecute you for your faith. In the verses before this Gospel passage, he tries to prepare us for that persecution and says that since it was done to him (Jesus), it would be done to his followers.

But what happened to Jesus? He was crucified, but rose from the dead. So he triumphed over his persecutors; they could not stop him. And that is what he promises us. Whatever persecution, ridicule, or discrimination we suffer for our faith, we cannot be destroyed as long as we keep that faith.

Now the best way to keep that faith is to give it away. That sounds like a paradox, but it means that when we spread the faith, our faith grows, too. Sure, it takes courage to talk about our faith to another, but when we share our stories about what God means to us, we relive those experiences; we remind ourselves what God has done for us. And when we allow others to share their faith with us, we are encouraged and supported. That is why Jesus says that what is hidden will be made known: True faith never stays hidden; it needs to be shared.

Sometimes we may hesitate to talk about our faith. If we let ourselves be tempted to silence, we are letting the devil have his way. That is the only thing to fear: not Satan's power, but our weakness. That's why Jesus said whoever denies him will be denied by him. Yet Jesus died for our sins, so even they cannot destroy us if we turn back to the Lord. Just as God knows every sparrow that falls, so he knows us when we fall and values us more than sparrows.

So thank him for his forgiveness, but don't forget to spread the news that you are forgiven. You might give someone else the courage to come back to the Lord, and so score another victory for faith over fear.

Someone once asked a wealthy man who contributed frequently to programs designed to help people why he was so generous to others.

The man did not seek publicity in his philanthropy, but seemed to want to share his good fortune for the sheer joy of giving.

"When I was a boy," he explained, "we lived in a small town where there wasn't much to do. One of our favorite swimming holes was under a railroad bridge and to reach it from town, we had to walk the railroad tracks for a half mile or so. We boys would often step up on one of the rails just to see who could walk the farthest without losing his balance. By accident really, one day, another boy and myself were side-by-side on the opposite rails. In balancing ourselves we both flung out our arms at the same time and discovered in that moment, that, if we clasped our hands together, we could both walk along much more easily and securely. Many years later, I observed how often people seem to lose their sense of balance in life. In acquiring possessions, some people become greedy and selfish. In misfortune, others become bitter and resentful. Then it came to me. On the road through life, we keep our own balance better, when we reach out to help the other fellow keep his balance, too."

**Lending Library**

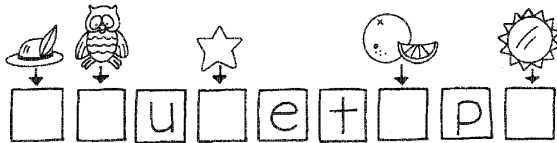
