Adoration Before the Altar of Repose

On Holy Thursday, just after the 7pm Mass of the Lord's Supper, we always have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament set up in Fr. Johnson Hall usually until midnight. This year, however, our Bishop has asked us to extend these hours. **Therefore, our Adoration before the Altar of Repose on Holy Thursday will continue throughout the night until 8am the following day.**

We would like you to recall our Lord's agony in the Garden of Gethsemane and His rebuke to His disciples: "What? Could you not watch one hour with me?" Please make arrangements to spend an hour with Our Lord, and **USE THE BOARD AT THE BACK OF THE CHURCH TO SIGN-UP.** We need to have at least **2 men** to sign-up from **midnight to 6am per hour.**

LENTEN PRACTICE CHALLENGE

We asked our students to practice a Lenten Fast, Prayer, and Almsgiving, and here are the results:

First Place: Post-Communion class with 41% participation.

Confirmation and First Communion both have 25% participation. One person from RCIA also participated. This year our students collected over \$400 for the Rice Bowl to fund the mission run by CRS (Catholic Relief Services) to serve the less fortunate on our behalf.

Congrats to our Post-Communion class again, fourth time winner since we started our Advent/Lenten spiritual practices. We understand that without the parents' participation we would not have a thriving faith formation program. Parents are the head of their Domestic Church by virtue of the sacrament of matrimony. Keep it up!
