# <u>Reflections of the Week</u>

The story of creation teaches us that God is the source of all life. God created all living things, including plants, animals, and human beings, as a testament to His great power and love for His creation. The fall of the first humans introduced death into the world, but God's plan for salvation ensures that death does not have the final say.

Ezekiel's prophecy of the resurrection of the Chosen People from their graves serves as a reminder of God's promise of eternal life for those who believe in Him. Jesus' miracle of raising Lazarus from the dead demonstrates the power of God to overcome death, although Lazarus would eventually die again. However, it is through Jesus' own resurrection from the dead that death is ultimately defeated and rendered powerless for all of humanity.

When Jesus arrives to comfort Martha and Mary, he shares in their grief and weeps with them. In his compassion, he calls upon his followers to participate in his work, even if it means facing unpleasant and challenging circumstances. When he calls Lazarus forth from the tomb, he also calls upon his friends and neighbors to embrace Lazarus' new life.

Lazarus' resurrection serves as a symbol of spiritual renewal and rebirth. When we turn away from God and our neighbors in need, we find ourselves in a state of spiritual death, separated from God and others. However, through Jesus' death and resurrection, we are called to new life in the Lord. We must listen to His call, respond to His grace, and allow the Holy Spirit to guide us towards eternal life. As Catholics, we believe that Jesus is the resurrection and the life, and that through Him, we too have the power of eternal life within us.


