

Reflections of the Week

Today's readings present us with a clear message about the power of faith and love. The first reading tells us of the remarkable acts of Philip, who, through the power of the Holy Spirit, healed many who were possessed by demons and disabled. This healing was a physical manifestation of God's forgiveness and a sign of a new age, an age where forgiveness and healing flow like water. The people of Samaria were filled with great joy and awe as they witnessed the power of God's love in action.

In the second reading, Peter reminds us that as Christians, we may suffer for our faith, but we must endure and respond with gentleness and reverence towards those who question us. We must follow the example of Jesus, who suffered for doing good, and respond with love to those who malign us. This is a true test of our faith, to love and show compassion to all, even our enemies.

In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that if we love Him, we will keep His commandments. Submission to God's will is a consequence of love, and it brings us a desire to do what God asks of us. Our love for God should inspire us to follow His commands and live our lives according to His will. Jesus promises us that if we keep His commands, He will ask the Father to send us the Holy Spirit, who will dwell within us forever.

We are all called to follow the examples of Philip, Peter, and Jesus, to show love and compassion to all, even those who may question or oppose our faith. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit may dwell within us, giving us the strength and courage to endure any suffering that may come our way, and to love others as Christ loves us.
