Reflections of the Week

Because God is a triune being—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—God's very nature is relational. Love and mercy are core to His essence, and these qualities naturally require an object of love. Without others to love, how can God be loving or merciful? This relational nature is reflected even in the creation narrative. In Proverbs 8:31, God's wisdom is described as taking "delight in the human race," and in the garden before the fall, God is seen walking with Adam and Eve, eager to interact with them. Yet, even before humanity existed, God's love was already expressed within the Trinity, as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit mutually shared love and faithfulness.

This relational foundation is key to who God is, and naturally, God invites us into relationship. The life of Jesus demonstrates this beautifully. He spent His days with His disciples, walking alongside them, sharing His deepest concerns—such as His upcoming death and resurrection—and demonstrating love through His actions, like calming storms and raising Lazarus. This ongoing relationship culminated in the sending of the Holy Spirit, who now dwells with us intimately, enabling us to remain in constant connection with God.

When we recite the Nicene Creed, we affirm our belief in the Trinity in a way that mirrors a commitment to a relationship, like wedding vows. Just as we declare our love and commitment to our spouse in marriage, the words "I believe in" repeated for each member of the Trinity express our desire to enter into a lasting, loving relationship with God—the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In this way, the creed is not merely a doctrinal statement, but a declaration of relational faith.

REVELATION

St. Augustine was walking along the beach, trying to understand the mystery of the Holy Trinity—how God can be three persons in one. He saw a boy filling a small hole in the sand with water from the ocean using a seashell.

Curious, Augustine asked, "What are you doing?"

The boy replied, "I'm trying to fit the entire ocean into this hole."

Augustine smiled and said, "That's impossible. The ocean is too big for such a small hole." The boy looked at him and said, "And so is the mystery of God too big for your mind to fully understand." Then the boy vanished.

Have you ever had a profound experience of the Holy Trinity in your life? Some may say yes. While we might not always recognize all three Persons together, we can still affirm their presence—especially in the Eucharist. In this sacred moment, God the Father lovingly gives us His Son, Jesus, in an act of profound sacrifice. The Holy Spirit sanctifies the gift, transforming simple bread into the very Body of Christ.

At Mass today, try to listen attentively to how all *three*—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—are present, offering Themselves to you in a very intimate way.
