

## Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross

Reflections of the Week

The cross was once only an instrument of torture and death. The Romans used it to punish and intimidate. But everything changed when Jesus was crucified. In Christ, the cross became not a symbol of oppression, but of redemption, love, and hope for eternal life. On the cross, Jesus revealed the heart of God and showed us how precious we are to the Father:

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son."

The cross teaches us humility, sacrifice, and the fullness of a life lived for others. It reminds us of the brevity of life and calls us to live with purpose, charity, and service. It unites humanity, compels us toward justice and compassion, and challenges us to confront suffering and injustice with mercy and courage.

Above all, the cross is the clearest sign of God's love and our greatest hope. As we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, we pray for victims of violence, such as the recent tragedy at Annunciation Church and School in Minnesota. May we embrace the cross anew and walk the way of Christ, which alone leads to life, hope, and peace.

Pope Leo XIV called the Cross of Christ the "greatest discovery of life," urging believers to look beyond surface realities to find the hidden treasure of hope within it—much like St. Helena's search for the True Cross. He also reflected on Jesus' thirst on the Cross as a cry for love and relationship, showing how our own human thirst becomes a bridge to heaven, revealing God's deep desire to share in our humanity.




You are invited to the "I AM Eucharistic Congress" on 10/18 and of course, you can also do so online. We will have another grace-filled
