Reflections of the Week

"Where Are the Other Nine?" — A Grateful Heart

When Jesus healed ten lepers, only one—a Samaritan—returned to give thanks. His gratitude set him apart, and Jesus said to him, *"Stand up and go; your faith has saved you."* Gratitude was the fruit of his faith, and faith became the path to his salvation.

A missionary once told of a young boy who walked many miles across the island to bring him a beautiful seashell as a gift. Surprised, the missionary said, "You walked all that way just to give me this?" The boy smiled and replied, "Long walk part of the gift."

So it is with gratitude—it moves the heart to go the extra mile. The thankful leper and the little boy both teach us that love always walks back to the Giver. Every step of gratitude is a return journey to God, who heals, provides, and saves. True faith doesn't just receive blessings—it recognizes the Giver and says, with joy, *thank You*.

Invitation

The Lord calls each of us to renewal — not just of mind, but of heart. In the quiet of prayer, in the beauty of the sacraments, and in the simple moments of daily life, God invites us to begin again. Spiritual renewal is not about becoming someone new, but about rediscovering who we are in Christ. Take a few moments in silence to reflect on the following:

Do I take time each day to return to Jesus with a grateful heart, recognizing His presence, healing and blessings in my life?

Listen and notice concrete ways the Lord inviting me to walk the "long road of gratitude."

Lord Jesus, open my eyes to recognize the blessings You pour into my life each day. Teach me to return to You with a heart full of thanks—to turn every blessing I receive into praise, service, and love for You. May gratitude shape my days, deepen my faith, and draw me ever closer to Your heart. Amen.
